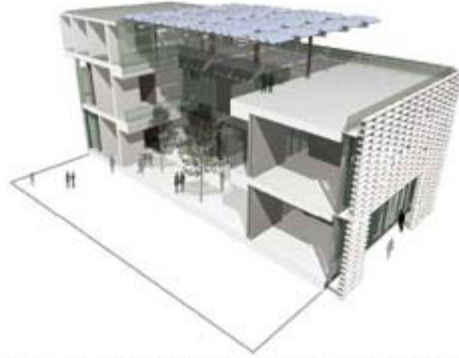


EMSI Awarded Shanghai Jiao Tong University Contract

SHANGHAI, China. Environmental Market Solutions, Inc. (EMSI), has been awarded a contract by Shanghai Jiao Tong University to assist in the design of the university's new Green Energy Laboratory (GEL). EMSI will work together with the project team as the green building consultant to help GEL achieve Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED®) for New Construction, the official green building rating system of the U.S. Green Building Council, targeting Gold Level. To assist in achieving this, EMSI will support the project team by evaluating different advanced green building strategies.



Shanghai Jiao Tong University's Green Energy Laboratory will serve as a test platform on building strategies and technologies for the climate of the middle and lower reaches of the Chang Jiang (Yangtze) River.

At over 16,000 square feet (1,490 square meters), GEL will house an exhibition center, a laboratory and offices. The GEL building is expected to be a study and test platform of building strategies and technologies such as energy saving devices and thermal comfort in the climate of the middle and lower reaches of the Chang Jiang (Yangtze) River. It will become a landmark building of Shanghai Jiao Tong University, showcasing many cutting-edge technologies in the fields of heating, ventilation and air-conditioning (HVAC), energy, building and environment science. The building will be an education platform for those students pursuing a major in the university's new major – building and environment.
